[Notes to the table]

- For example, the value "206" in the dose row " 1<Dose ≤2" in the period column "October–December 2017" indicates that there were 206 workers engaged in decontamination and related work in the three months from October to December 2017 who had a dose higher than 1 mSv and equal to or lower than 2 mSv.
- This table shows the dose distribution per quarter, collected as of 23 January 2019 for the past one year.
- The data are given as a flash report of the dose distribution among workers engaged in decontamination and related work in the third quarter (July–September of 2018) as well as additional data for the period from the fourth quarter of 2017 to the second quarter of 2018 (October 2017 to June 2018) which were added after the flash data collection day (17 October 2018)
