[Notes to the table]

- For example, the value “ 2 ” in the dose row “ 1<Dose ≤2 ” in the period column “October – December 2024” indicates that there were 2 workers engaged in decontamination and related work in the three months from October to December 2024 who had a dose higher than 1 mSv and equal to or lower than 2 mSv.
- This table shows the dose distribution per quarter, collected as of 13 January 2026 for the past one year.
- The data are given as a flash report of the dose distribution among workers engaged in decontamination and related work in the third quarter (July – September of 2025) as well as additional data for the period from the fourth quarter of 2024 to the second quarter of 2025 (October 2024 to June 2025) which were added after the flash data collection day (14 October 2025).
